

COVID-19 Student Screening Flowchart

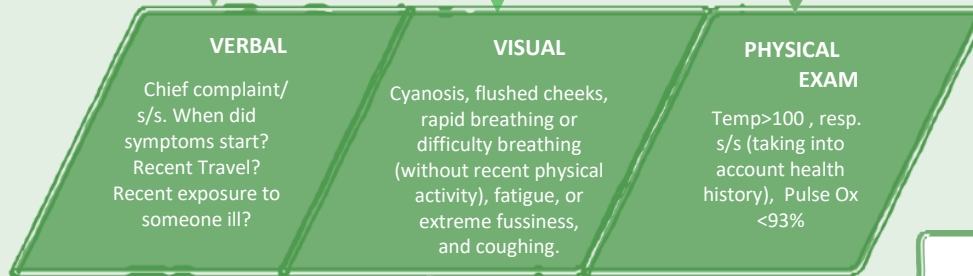
This flowchart will be used for nursing staff to provide guidance on students who may present to the health office with COVID-19 or MIS-C like symptoms. This does not replace judgement based on identified findings or case by case nursing assessment.

Student exhibits symptoms. Teacher calls nurse. Student presents to Health Office.

Pediatric patients with COVID-19/MIS-C may experience the following signs or symptoms over the course of the disease:

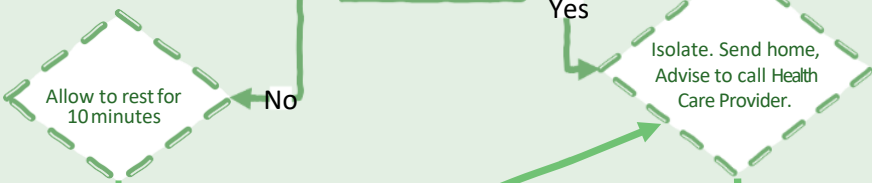
- Fever
- Cough
- Nasal congestion or rhinorrhea
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting
- Fatigue/extreme fatigue Myalgia
- Headache
- New loss of taste/smell
- Poor feeding or poor appetite

Other: rash, red eyes, cracked/swollen lips, red/swollen tongue, swelling hands/feet, stomach pain, neck pain CDC 5/29/20



Verbal, Visual, Physical Concerns or Out of Range

- CALL EMS**
- Difficulty breathing
 - Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
 - New confusion
 - Inability to wake or stay awake
 - Bluish lips or face/Pulse ox < 93%



Improving - notify parent or guardian

Notify Administration & Health Department prn for Presumptive COVID-19 case. Notify counselor, teacher/attendance
